## ADDENDUM # 1 TO THE 2022-2027 AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO AND

## SACRAMENTO COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFFS' ASSOCIATION IN THE NON-SUPERVISORY LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT

Revise Section 9.1 as follows:

## 9.1 HOLIDAYS

Regular employees shall be granted one (1) day off every four (4) weeks in lieu of prescribed holidays. Such time off shall be designated in the employee's regular work schedule. If not scheduled and taken every four (4) weeks, such time shall accrue at the rate of 4.3 hours each biweekly pay period. Effective December 18, 2022, this amount will be increased to 4.6 hours each biweekly pay period. On any day which the department closes or partially closes an office, unit, or operation, such affected employees shall be required to utilize accrued holiday time or vacation, whichever is closest to the maximum accrual limit, to cover their absence. The accrual limit for holiday time shall be 104 hours, with any accrual in excess of the 104 hours limit paid to the employee in cash.

This Addendum shall remain in full force and effect to and including June 30, 2027.
